

- MAKING A FIGATURE -



You will need -

1. A pair of scissors (or a craft knife)
2. A ruler
3. Glue
4. Your printed figatures – we recommend you print onto 180 or 200 gsm card



Begin by roughly cutting out one of the figatures.

When cutting out the figure, cut so that you create a 'V' shape in the top centre – see above.

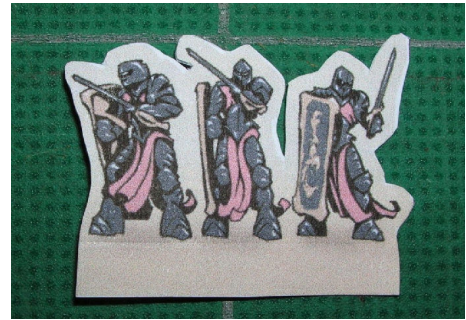
Also make a slit in the middle-bottom where indicated in the above image by a red line.



Now score a line just beneath the 'feet' of the figatures.



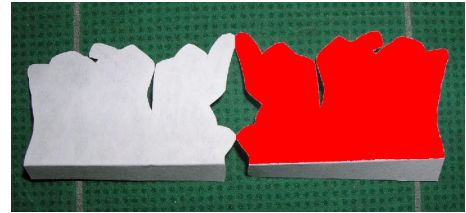
Fold the figure in half – the 'V' at the top and the slit you made will help with this.



With the figure folded in half, cut around the image using the outline as a guide.



Unfold the figure and fold up the bottom of each half along your score line.



Turn the figure over and apply glue to one side – i.e. the area in red in the above image.



Then glue the two halves together and your figure is complete!
